Re: Request for the Toronto Board of Health to examine ways to curtail the excessive feeding of large flocks of pigeons

Dear Councillor Filion:

I have been approached by residents of Ward 30 who are concerned about the excessive feeding of large flocks of pigeons and the overwhelming amount of pigeon waste that is accumulating in their neighbourhood. Because of their routine feeding by one resident, hundreds of pigeons have been nesting in trees. The waste is accumulating on cars, on their neighbour's furniture and property and is prohibiting those living on the street from sitting in their yard.

I am requesting that the Medical Officer of Health report back on ways to curtail excessive feeding of large flocks of pigeons and include what other municipalities are doing in this regard.
