### **3.0** Toronto Food Strategy Discussion Paper Presentation: Brian Cook

- Brian Cook gave background information on the Food Strategy report and requested input/comments from the Committee on what they thought is missing from the strategy.
- Judi Wilkie answered questions on the various Public Health nutrition programs.
- A variety of topics were discussed for consideration and inclusion in the strategy.
- Brian requested any further comments be emailed to him.
- LIHN is not involved in the Food Strategy at the moment.
- The MOH is meeting to discuss the strategy.
- Valerie thanked Brian and Judi for attending our meeting, sharing and clarifying information for us.

#### 4.0 Board of Health Follow Up from Strategic Planning Session and January Agenda

• The North Local Health Committee's priorities were discussed at the BOH retreat and were all incorporated.

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- The agenda for the Strategic Planning Session was to develop a common understanding, to set major goals, and to discuss the level of responsibility, whether it be government, provincial or municipal, and who should be advocating to partner together.
- It is our understanding that all the information discussed at this meeting will be summarized and returned to us. No date has been established.
- Valerie will share the information as it becomes available.

# January BOH Agenda

- Valerie discussed items of interest such as:
  - poverty issue in Toronto;
  - Smoke Free Ontario Act has an amendment to protect children and youth from second hand smoke in motor vehicles.
- Valerie received a letter from the Ministry on the new Ontario Public Health Standards which is replacing the Mandatory Guidelines.
  - Different consultations, on various dates, are being held and all health units have been asked to participate.
  - Feedback will be done through a website and electronic surveys. There will be a verbal presentation on this at the Board of Health meeting.
- TPH looked at 25 chemicals that can affect the health of the population.
  - Drycleaners have been found to be major polluters. A website is being released January 7th for the public.
- Valerie shared the document "Environmental Reporting and Disclosure Report".
- ACTION: Eleanor will send out the electronic version of the Environmental Reporting and Disclosure Report to the members to review before the next meeting.
  - Can be added to agenda for next meeting.
- **ACTION:** Sara will contact Rick Waite, Health Consultant, to find out the deadline for feedback of this document.

### 5.0 New Business

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- 5.1 Parks, Forestry and Recreation *Everybody Gets to play* Strategy and Public Consultation January 17<sup>th</sup>, 7-8 p.m. NYCC, Council Chambers (see attached report).
  - This item has received a lot of media coverage lately so was added to the Agenda.
    - This will remain on the Agenda for the next meeting.
      - There is concern about increase in fees for programs.
      - Parks & Rec. are having a community consultation regarding this on Thursday, January 18<sup>th</sup> from 7-9 p.m. More information is available on the Parks & Rec. website.
- **ACTION:** Sara will go to the meeting and will report back.
- **ACTION:** Janet can bring views from other community outlets to the next meeting.
- **ACTION:** Valerie recommended Sara get a representative from P&R to come and speak to the committee.

# 5.2 2008 International Year of Sanitation – Earle Straus

- Earle looked into Toronto's water quality and loss of fresh water due to leakage problems. Water and sewer pipes are old and sewage leakage can affect the fresh water system.
- Valerie recommended that we get additional information, document our findings and continue our discussion.

**ACTION:** Earle offered to look into this further and report back to the Committee.

- The Committee will then determine the next steps.
- A representative from the Water Department could be asked to come and address the committee.

# 5.3 Immunization re Travel Awareness – Anna Walsh

- More public awareness and education is needed on travel immunization
- Valerie recommended we start by finding out what is available.
- ACTION: Sara will get information from the public health vaccine preventable department on what social marketing strategies are currently being done to promote travellers getting their Hepatitis A and B shot before heading south.
