EXISTING STREET FOOD VENDOR MENU EXPANSION PILOT PROJECT PARAMETERS

Changes to Regulation 562 allow street food vendors to expand their menu beyond the current offering of hot dogs and sausages. A pilot project will assess the impact of allowing an expansion to their menu.

- 1. Up to 15 existing hot dog/sausage vendors will be permitted to participate.
- 2. Existing vendors will apply to participate in the pilot.
- 3. Applicants will be requested to identify the additional food items to be sold.
- 4. Food items will be restricted to the following:
 - a. Pre-packaged fruits and vegetables using only vinaigrette dips
 - b. Whole fruits and vegetables, including corn on the cob
 - c. Pre-packaged fruit salad
 - d. Bagels with individual serving containers of butter, margarine, peanut butter or jam
 - e. Pre-packaged nuts and seeds
 - f. Pre-packaged salads containing only vegetables and/or fruits with all dressings to be pre-packaged and not requiring refrigeration
 - g. Pre-packaged Tabbouleh salad & pita bread
 - h. Soups
 - i. Pre-cooked veggie burgers
 - i. Coffees and teas
- 5. Vendors will be selected based upon the following criteria:
 - a. Proposed menu expansion
 - b. Willingness to provide post pilot feedback
 - c. Willingness to post compliance signage
 - d. Agreement to be in a fixed location (for inspection purposes)
 - e. Successful completion of the Certified Food Handler course
 - f. Current compliance with all City by-laws
 - g. History of compliance with respect to food safety
- 6. Pilot vendors will be selected to achieve a distribution of 5% of the existing vendors located within the boundaries of each former local municipality. Where more vendors meet the criteria than required to attain a 5% sample base, a lottery system will be used to select the required number of vendors, while maintaining the requirement of including a cross-section of foods and geographic locations.
