Parking Regulations: Fairlawn Avenue, Bathurst Street to Barse Street

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that the Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To obtain approval to amend parking prohibitions on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue, between Bathurst Street and Barse Street.

The amendment to the parking prohibitions will address the resident's concerns with respect to excessive on-street parking occurring on the north side of the roadway.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services Division, North York District recommends that:

- 1. Schedule VIII of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, be amended to delete the No Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, prohibition on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue, from Bathurst Street to a point 63 metres east.
- 2. Schedule VIII of By-law No. 31001, of the former City of North York, be amended to prohibit parking from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue, from Bathurst Street to Barse Street.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the amendments of the parking regulations are included within the Transportation Services Division's 2008 Operating Budget estimates.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Transportation Services Division, North York District, was requested by Councillor Karen Stintz on behalf of a resident, to review the feasibility of amending the parking regulations on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue.

COMMENTS

Currently, parking is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue, from Bathurst Street to a point 63 metres east. Parking is also prohibited at anytime on the south side of Fairlawn Avenue from the easterly limit of Bathurst Street to a point 91.5 metres east of the easterly limit of Bathurst Street.

The parking prohibitions on the south side of the roadway encompass the frontage of the resident's home; however, parking is permitted on the north side of the roadway opposite his home which restricts egress from his driveway.

Staff of this division have confirmed that vehicles parked on the north side of Fairlawn Avenue in front of residences do indeed obstruct egress from driveways.

Councillor Karen Stintz supports the recommendations of this staff report.
