# 40 km/h Speed Zones: Banting Avenue, Embro Drive, Findlay Boulevard and Reiner Road

#### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that the Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To deny the request to install 40 km/h speed zones on Banting Avenue, Embro Drive, Findlay Boulevard and Reiner Road.

The existing traffic and roadway conditions do not warrant the introduction of a 40 km/h speed limit on any of the above-noted roadways.

# RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services, North York District recommends that:

- 1. the installation of a 40 km/h speed limit on Banting Avenue not be implemented;
- 2. the installation of a 40 km/h speed limit on Embro Drive not be implemented;
- 3. the installation of a 40 km/h speed limit on Findlay Boulevard not be implemented; and
- 4. the installation of a 40 km/h speed limit on Reiner Road, from Wilson Heights Boulevard to Banting Avenue not be implemented.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with the adoption of this report.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

The Transportation Services Division, North York District, has been requested by Councillor Michael Feldman, on behalf of the community, to investigate the feasibility of installing 40 km/h speed zones on Banting Avenue, Embro Drive, Findlay Boulevard and Reiner Road, from Wilson Heights Boulevard to Banting Road.

#### COMMENTS

Banting Avenue, Embro Drive, Findlay Boulevard and Reiner Road are designated as two-lane local roads with regulatory speed limits of 50 km/h, and consist of single family residential properties. It should be noted that the vacant lands on the west side of Banting Avenue have been recently redeveloped as a park (Banting Park).

In view of the residents' requests, this division has undertaken 24-hour vehicle volume and speed studies on all of the above-noted roadways. The results of these studies are as follows:

The City of Toronto policy for introducing a 40 km/h speed limit considers various roadway characteristics, safety concerns, collision patterns and the location of pedestrian generators such as schools, parks and the absence of municipal sidewalks. A copy of the 40 km/h Warrant Summary sheet is attached.

As there are municipal sidewalks on all of the above-noted roadways, a reduction in the speed limit to 40 km/h is not warranted.

Councillor Michael Feldman has been informed of the recommendations of this staff report.
