**BY-LAW No. -2008**

**To permanently close the public lane extending southerly from Hollywood Avenue at the rear of Nos. 181 to 185 Willowdale Avenue**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane extending southerly from Hollywood Avenue at the rear of Nos. 181 to 185 Willowdale Avenue be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in North York Community Council Item NY5.27, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on May 23, 24 and 25, 2007; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the North York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the North York Community Council] at its meeting held on January 15, 2008;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane extending southerly from Hollywood Avenue at the rear of Nos. 181 to 185 Willowdale Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:
