The Council of the City of Toronto proposes to pass a by-law to permanently close a public lane at the rear of 181 to 185 Willowdale Avenue, extending south from Hollywood Avenue shown as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-23339, in the City of Toronto (former City of North York).

At its meeting to be held in the **Council Chamber at the North York Civic Centre, Lower Level on Tuesday, January 15, 2008 at 9:45 a.m., the North York Community Council** will hear in person or by his or her counsel, agent or solicitor, any person who wishes to speak to the matter of the **proposed by-law**.
