Subject: **Jamieson Avenue Crossing – Request for Temporary Accessible Pedestrian Crossing from Parkdale to the Waterfront.**

Recommendation:

The Toronto Pedestrian Committee recommended to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee that the City install a temporary accessible pedestrian crossing from Parkdale to the Waterfront, in close proximity to the Jamieson Avenue crossing, to provide access during the closure of the Jamieson Avenue crossing.

Background:

The Toronto Pedestrian Committee on May 13, 2008 considered a verbal report from Roger Brook, Member, Toronto Pedestrian Committee, advising that the Jamieson Avenue Crossing will be closed for the summer and that there will be no access from Parkdale to the Waterfront.
