**Recommendations:**

**The Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee requests the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee to:**

- 1. Request the General Manager, Transportation Services Division, to consult with Toronto Police Service and report to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee on:**
  - a. strategies to reduce illegal parking in bike lanes, such report to include, but not be limited to, a survey of other jurisdictions, enactment of any new by-laws necessary to improve enforcement and consideration to increasing the fine for illegally parking in the bike lane; and**
  - b. strategies to reduce dooring-related collisions, such report to include, but not be limited to, a survey of other jurisdictions, enactment of any new by-laws necessary to improve enforcement and consideration to increasing the fine for dooring collisions.**
