Subject: Traffic Control Signal Study – Morningside Avenue and Tams Road

Recommendations:

The Scarborough Community Council recommended that the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee and City Council:

- 1. Approve the installation of traffic control signals at the intersection of Morningside Avenue and Tams Road.**
- 2. Amend the appropriate by-law(s) accordingly.**
- 3. Receive the report (August 6, 2008) from the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District.**

Decision Advice and Other Information:

The Scarborough Community Council also requested the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District to:

- a. examine speed reduction measures in the vicinity of the semi-actuated traffic control signals on Morningside Avenue and Tams Road; and
- b. report to Scarborough Community Council on the impact of installing traffic control signals at this location on Morningside Yard and the Reuse Centre should it proceed.

Background:

The Scarborough Community Council on October 7, 2008, considered a report (August 6, 2008) from the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District, on the feasibility of the installation of traffic control signals at Morningside Avenue and Tams Road.
