**BY-LAW No. -2008**

**To permanently close to vehicular traffic a portion of the north boulevard of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East between Leslie Street and Carlaw Avenue**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the north boulevard of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East be permanently closed to vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council] at its meeting held on April 8, 2008;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

Part of PIN 21053-0069 (LT)

Part of the 150 Foot Wide Road on Plan 159E designated as Parts 1 and 3 on Plan 2008-0367 and part of the 150 Foot Wide Road on Plan 159E and part of the Water Lot in front of Lot 11 Broken Front Concession in the geographic Township of York designated as Part 1 on Plan 2008-0367-1.
