### One-Hour Maximum Parking Regulation - Ulster Street

### SUMMARY

---

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Community Council to restrict parking to a maximum period of one hour, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the north side of Ulster Street, from Brunswick Avenue to Lippincott Street. The one-hour regulation is consistent with other sections of the street, and combined with sufficient enforcement, should result in more parking opportunities for local residents.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

---

**Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:**

1. Rescind the one hour, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. maximum parking regulation on the north side of Ulster Street, from Bathurst Street to Lippincott Street.
2. Allow parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., on the north side of Ulster Street from Bathurst Street to Brunswick Avenue.

## ISSUE BACKGROUND

At the request of Councillor Adam Vaughan on behalf of local residents, staff reviewed a request to increase opportunities for residents to find parking spaces on Ulster Street, between Brunswick Avenue and Lippincott Street during daytime hours.

## COMMENTS

Ulster Street, from Brunswick Avenue to Lippincott Street, is a local road, approximately 7.3 metres wide. It operates one-way westbound from Borden Street to Lippincott Street and one-way eastbound from Borden Street to Brunswick Street. There is no TTC service on Ulster Street. The following regulations are posted on this section of Ulster Street:

North Side:

- Parking by permit only – 12 midnight to 7:00 a.m., daily (Area 6D);
- three hour parking at all other times.

South Side:

- No Parking Anytime.

Parking is restricted elsewhere on Ulster Street to a maximum period of one hour during the daytime to discourage long term parking by non-residents. Implementing a one-hour maximum parking regulation from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Ulster Street, from Lippincott Street to Brunswick Avenue should provide more parking turnover and would be consistent with neighbouring sections of Ulster Street.
