Good afternoon Councillor Vaughan, Steam Whistle Brewing has recently been invited to participate in a new program by the AGCO that allows licenced manufacturer's of beer and liquor in Ontario to sell and serve wine and beer, by the glass, in their on-site tasting rooms. This program is entitled 'The Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Sales Licence' or, is otherwise known as a 'By the Glass Licence'. I have attached an information form of this program for you to look at. We would like to move forward with this as quickly as possible, as we are rapidly entering the busy tourist season in Toronto. Our brewery is a tourist hot spot that often sees over a thousand people a day during the peak summer season. The 'By the Glass' licence would allow us to enhance the Toronto tourist experience at our brewery. In order for the AGCO to issue this licence, each participating brewery or winery must secure Municipal approval before submitting an application, which is why we've contacted you. We would like to know what is involved in achieving Municipal Consent for this licence, and if there is any way to expedite this process so that there is the possibility of acquiring this license for the summer.
