

Appendix B
Queen Street West, from Gladstone Avenue to Dovercourt Road

Rescind the following parking regulations:

1. “No Stopping, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays.”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Spadina Avenue and Triller Avenue;
2. “No Stopping, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Triller Avenue and Spadina Avenue;
3. “Two-hour Maximum Parking, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Ossington Avenue;
4. “Two-hour Maximum Parking, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Ossington Avenue;
5. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Ossington Avenue; and
6. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Ossington Avenue.

Implement the following parking regulations:

1. “No Stopping, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Triller Avenue and Gladstone Avenue;
2. “No Stopping, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Dovercourt Road;
3. “No Stopping, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Dovercourt Road and Spadina Avenue;

4. “No Stopping, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Spadina Avenue and Dovercourt Road
5. “No Stopping, from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Dovercourt Road and Gladstone Avenue;
6. “No Stopping, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Triller Avenue;
7. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Gladstone Avenue and Dovercourt Road;
8. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday”, on the south side of Queen Street West, between Dovercourt Road and Ossington Avenue;
9. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday”, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Ossington Avenue and Dovercourt Road; and
10. “Three-hour Maximum Parking” regulation requiring the use of parking machines, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the north side of Queen Street West, between Dovercourt Road and Gladstone Avenue.

Implement the following turn regulations:

1. “No Left Turn, from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday to Friday” by westbound traffic on Queen Street West at Lisgar Street;
2. “No Left Turn, from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday to Friday” by westbound traffic on Queen Street West at Abell Street; and
3. “No Left Turn, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday” by eastbound traffic on Queen Street West at Beaconsfield Avenue.
