**BY-LAW No.**

**To permanently close a portion of the public lane abutting 17 to 25 Gledhill Avenue**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the portion of the public lane abutting 17 to 25 Gledhill Avenue, shown as Part 1 on PS-2005-009, be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 111 of Report No. 7 of Toronto and East York Community Council, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on September 25, 26 and 27, 2006; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council] at its meeting held on \_\_\_\_\_, 2008;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane abutting 17 to 25 Gledhill Avenue, shown as Part 1 on PS-2005-009, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:
