Dear Ms. Thornback:

In your letter of April 24, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 520 Wellington Street West.

Ballots were mailed out on May 20, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being June 18, 2008. The following is the poll result:

Chapter 313 of the Municipal Code states that a poll can only proceed when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the minimum response rate and therefore is considered negative. Please note that this poll cannot be conducted again until June 18, 2010, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
