Dear Ms Thornback:

In your letter of June 11, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 281 Augusta Avenue.

Ballots were mailed out on July 8, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being August 6, 2008. The following is the poll result:

No. of Returned Ballots Needed to Proceed (must be at least 25%)	24
Actual Number of Returned Ballots	13
In Favour of Boulevard Café	9
Opposed to Boulevard Café	4
Spoiled Ballots	0
No Reply	83

Chapter 313 of the Municipal Code states that a poll can only proceed when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the minimum response rate and therefore is considered negative. Please note that this poll cannot be conducted again until August 6, 2010, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
