Dear Ms Thornback:

In your letter of June 11, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 1192 Queen Street East.

Ballots were mailed out on June 25, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being July 24, 2008. The following is the poll result:

No. of Returned Ballots Needed to Proceed (must be at least 25%)	28
Actual Number of Returned Ballots	25
In Favour of Boulevard Café	17
Opposed to Boulevard Café	6
Spoiled Ballots	2
No Reply	85

Chapter 313 of the Municipal Code states that a poll can only proceed when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the minimum response rate and therefore is considered negative. Please note that this poll cannot be conducted again until July 24, 2010, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
