In your letter of July 8, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 703 College Street.

Ballots were mailed out on July 9, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being August 7, 2008. The following is the poll result:

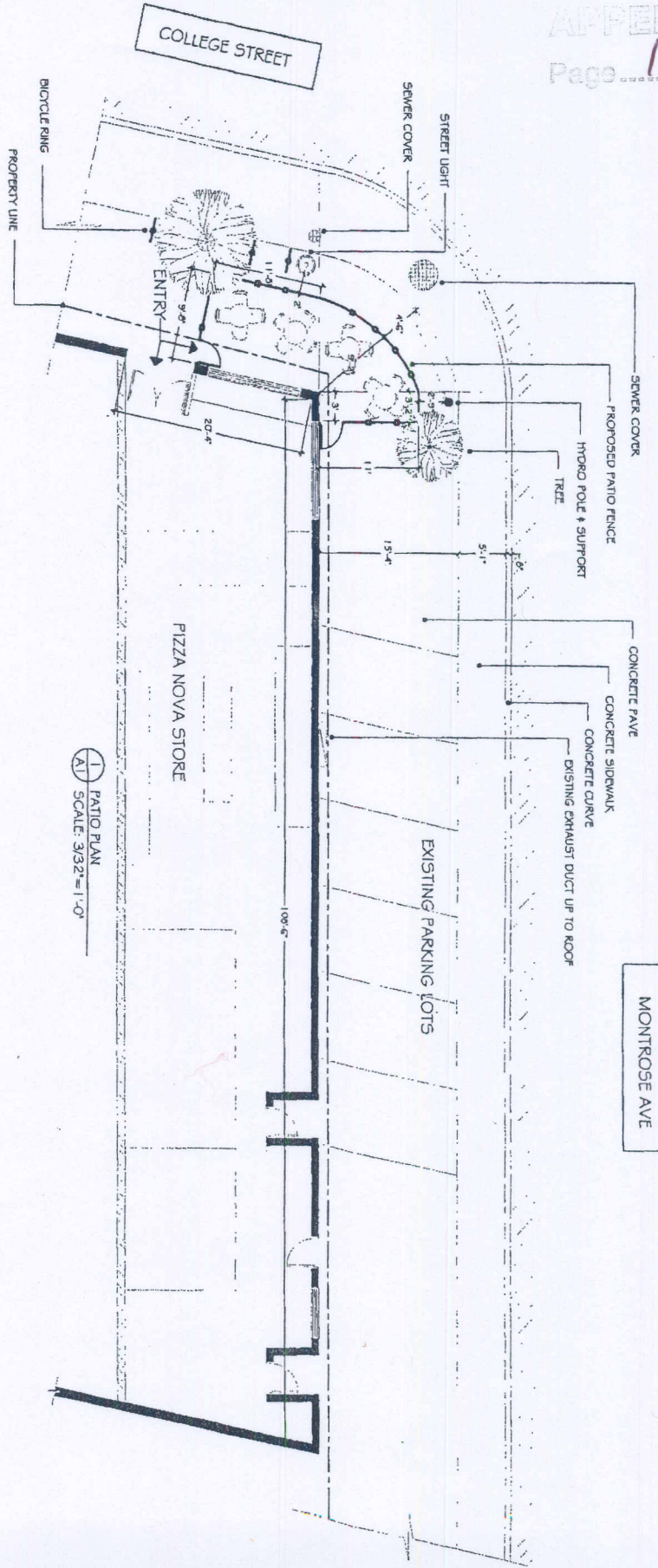

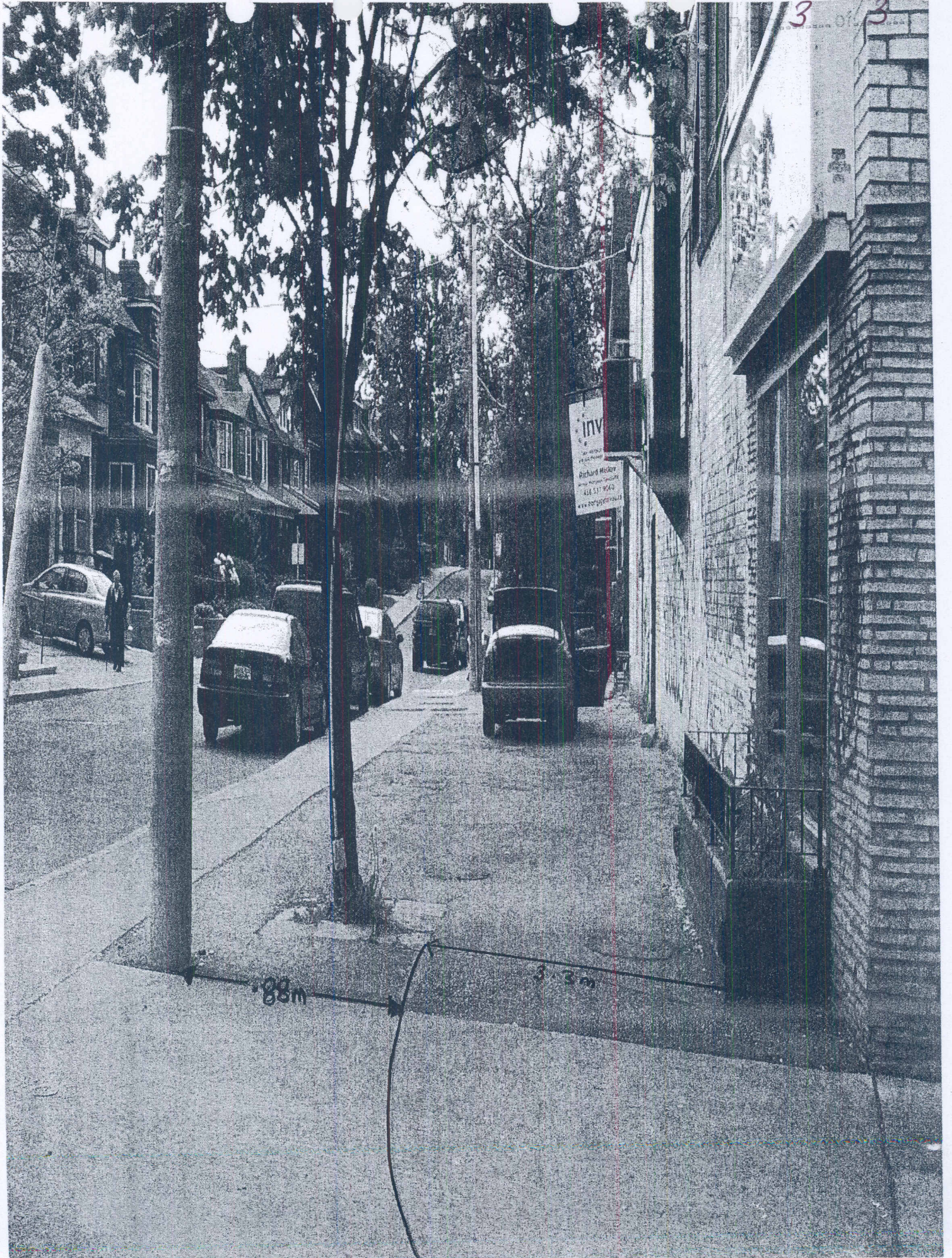
