Reduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking Hours - Eldon Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Community Council to reduce the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Eldon Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Dentonia Park Avenue, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

The reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours would allow non permit holders, such as visitors and tradespersons, to park for a maximum period of three hours during non-permit parking hours, without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. reduce the overnight on-street permit parking hours of operation on Eldon Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Dentonia Park Avenue, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

A request was received from Councillor Janet Davis, on behalf of area residents, to reduce overnight on-street permit parking hours on Eldon Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Dentonia Park Avenue, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

COMMENTS

Eldon Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Dentonia Park Avenue is a local street operating in a two way north/south bound direction with a pavement width of 8.5 metres. No TTC service operates on Eldon Avenue. Currently parking is allowed on alternate sides of the street for a maximum period of three hours with overnight on-street permit parking in effect from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

A Public Notice was placed in a major newspaper on September 19, 2008, with an expiration date to raise objections of October 3, 2008. The Clerk has confirmed that no written objection was received by the expiration date.

Area residents requested the reduction of the on-street permit parking hours to alleviate the problem of tagging of their guests and tradespersons.
