# **SUMMARY**

The Protocol for Responses to Audit Recommendations by Agencies, Boards and Commissions sets out a formal reporting process whereby responses to an Audit report are co-ordinated through the City Clerk's Office and forwarded to the Audit Committee.

This report provides the Audit Committee with the responses from those agencies, boards, commissions and corporations (ABCCs) which were requested by City Council to report on the development and implementation of human rights policies and complaints procedures by June 2009. It also notes those ABCCs which have not yet submitted a response.

Staff from the City Manager's Office have been consulted during the preparation of this report.

#### **DECISION HISTORY**

At its meeting on December 1, 2 and 3, 2008, City Council adopted Audit Committee Item AU9.4, headed "Audit of City Performance in Achieving Access, Equity and Human Rights Goals" (<a href="http://www.toronto.ca/legdocs/mmis/2008/au/reports/2008-11-04-au09-cr.pdf">http://www.toronto.ca/legdocs/mmis/2008/au/reports/2008-11-04-au09-cr.pdf</a>). City Council made the following request:

City Council request all agencies, boards, commissions and corporations to report to Council, by June 2009, on whether they have developed a human rights policy and related complaint procedures, whether the policy and procedures are in keeping with provisions in the City's policy and procedures, and implementation of these policies and procedures.

By letter dated April 2, 2009, the City Manager advised the affected agencies, boards, commissions and corporations of Council's action, and requested that responses be forwarded to the City Clerk's Office for co-ordination and submission to the Audit Committee.

In early June, the City Clerk reminded those ABCCs that had not yet responded to Council's request for information.

City staff continue to work with the ABCCs to assist with the implementation of Council's directions concerning access, equity and human rights. Staff from the Social Development, Finance and Administration Division are currently working with the Association of Community Centres (AOCCs) to develop a harmonized Human Rights Policy. As well, the City Manager's Office is in the process of reviewing the reporting format for access, equity and human rights initiatives being undertaken by City Divisions and this will be shared with the major ABCCs. The City Manager intends to provide a status report to City Council in September, 2010 in this regard.
