Committee Recommendations:

The Toronto Pedestrian Committee recommended to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee that:

- 1. the Toronto Pedestrian Committee be included in the review of future road projects, particularly those with streetcar stop alterations; and
- 2. given that the parking supply in the recommended alternative is greater than the observed peak demand, the next phase of design work investigate the possibility of removing additional parking spaces in low demand areas in order to widen sidewalks or provide bicycle parking.

The Toronto Pedestrian Committee endorsed the general Roncesvalles Avenue plan.
