SUMMARY

On November 24, 2009, the City Clerk was requested to report on the feasibility and costs of providing transportation for electors with disabilities to the voting places if disabled accessibility cannot be achieved within a local voting area.

There is insufficient time to obtain detailed information from various City divisions and complete this feasibility study for the December 2, 2009 City Council meeting.

RECOMMENDATIONS

City Council request the City Clerk and the City Manager to report to the Executive Committee for its meeting on February 1, 2010 on the feasibility and costs of providing transportation for electors with disabilities to the voting places if disabled accessibility cannot be achieved within a local voting area.
