Dear Ms Thornback:

In your letter of October 23, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 3079 Dundas Street West.

Ballots were mailed out on November 12, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being December 11, 2008. The following is the poll result:

Opposed to Boulevard Café	2
Spoiled Ballots	1
No Reply	82

Chapter 190 of the Municipal Code states that a poll can only proceed when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the minimum response rate and therefore is considered negative. Please note that this poll cannot be conducted again until December 11, 2010, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
