NAMING the proposed private lanes at 156, 160 Evans Avenue, 829, 833, 839 Oxford Street as “**Ruby Lang Lane**” and “**Cormier Heights**”.

At its meeting to be held in the **Council Chambers, Etobicoke Civic Centre, 399 The West Mall, Etobicoke, on May 14 2009 at 10:00 a.m., or shortly thereafter, the Etobicoke Community Council** will hear in person or by his or her counsel, agent or solicitor, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard, with respect to the proposed by-law.
