92 Brydon Drive - Stopping Regulation Amendment

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to propose the introduction of a stopping prohibition on the west side of a portion of Brydon Drive for 9 metres on either side of the driveway to 92 Brydon Drive. This stopping regulation will ensure good sightlines for motorists exiting from the driveway as well as provide manoeuvring room for trucks accessing the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Enacting a “No Stopping Anytime” prohibition on the west side of Brydon Drive from a point 48 metres south of Airview Road to a point 29 metres further south.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Transportation Services attended a meeting with the area Councillor as well as a representative of the business at 92 Brydon Drive to discuss concerns with vehicles parked close to the driveway to this property creating sightline concerns. A map of the area is Attachment 1.

COMMENTS

Brydon Drive is an 8.5 metres wide two-way local road built to rural standards (gravel shoulders and ditches) with a speed limit of 50 km/h. No sidewalks are located on this industrial road located west of Kipling Avenue and north of Rexdale Boulevard.

Industrial development exists along the majority of this road as well as places of worship and a school. Parking is currently allowed along the west side of this road, up to the city wide three hour maximum limit. On the east side, along the back of Monsignor Percy Johnson School property, parking is prohibited between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

A review of the collision history in the area involving parked vehicles or vehicles exiting from area driveways for a five-year period for which we have complete data (January 1, 2004 to December 31, 2008), revealed that there have been no reported collisions.

Based on our review, we can support the request from the area business to prohibit stopping on a small portion of one side of the street to improve sightlines at the driveway to 92 Brydon Drive. As there are places of worship on this street, by prohibiting stopping, police parking consideration would not be offered for these spaces. However, the impact is minimal as only two parking spaces will be removed.
