SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to rescind the existing "One Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday" regulation, on the east and west sides of Britannia Avenue from St. Clair Avenue West to the northerly terminus of the street.

This proposed parking regulation amendment will allow residents and visitors to park for a maximum of three hours on the east and west sides of Britannia Avenue.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Rescinding the "One Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday" on the east and west sides of Britannia Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and the northerly terminus street.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The Transportation Services Division received a request from the office of Councillor Frances Nunziata on behalf of the Britannia Avenue area residents to rescind the existing one-hour, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday parking regulation on the east and west sides of Britannia Avenue to give residents and visitors opportunities to park for longer than one hour on the street. A petition was completed by the area residents and submitted to Staff to demonstrate support for this request. A map of the area is Attachment 1.

COMMENTS

Britannia Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and the north terminus of the street, is an approximately 8.53 metre wide, two-way local road with sidewalks on the east and west sides of the street and a statutory speed limit of 50 km/h.

Parking is allowed for a maximum period of one hour from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday on the east and west sides of Britannia Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and the north terminus of the street. Permit Parking is in effect on both sides of Britannia Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and the north terminus of the street from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00a.m., and at all other times parking is allowed for a maximum period of three hours.

The proposed rescindment of the existing one-hour parking for Britannia Avenue will effectively allow residents and visitors opportunities to park for longer periods of time but for a maximum period of three hours.
