**Humber Boulevard South – Parking Regulation
Amendment**

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to modify the existing Humber Boulevard South parking regulations to allow three-hour parking for a small section of the roadway, on the south side of Humber Boulevard South, from a point 85 metres east of Hilldale Road and a point 65.5 metres east thereof.

This parking regulation amendment will accommodate overflow evening parking for residents and visitors to 101 Humber Boulevard South.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Rescinding the existing “No Parking Anytime” on the south side of Humber Boulevard South, from Hilldale Road to Avon Avenue.
2. Enacting a “No Parking Anytime” prohibition on the south side of Humber Boulevard South, from Hilldale Road to a point 85 metres east thereof and from a point 150.5 metres east of Hilldale Road to Avon Avenue.
3. Enacting a “No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Daily” prohibition on the south side of Humber Boulevard South, from a point 85 metres east of Hilldale Road to a point 65.5 metres further east.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The Transportation Services Division received a request from the office of Councillor Frances Nunziata on behalf of the residents of building Premises 101 Humber Boulevard South to allow less restrictive on-street parking fronting this property. A map of the area is Attachment 1.

COMMENTS

Humber Boulevard South, between Hilldale Road and Avon Avenue, is an 8.7 metre wide, two-lane, two-way collector road with sidewalks on the north and south sides of the street and a statutory speed limit of 40 km/h. This road provides access to residential properties and a secondary school in this area. Parking is currently prohibited anytime on the north and south sides of Humber Boulevard South between Hilldale Road and Avon Avenue.

At the request of the tenants of the multi-dwelling building occupying 101 Humber Boulevard South, Transportation Services staff investigated concerns regarding insufficient overnight resident and visitor parking. Allowing the standard three-hour parking from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily on the south side of Humber Boulevard South, between a point 85 metres east of Hilldale Road to a point 65.5 metres east thereof, for a small section of roadway, will have no significant traffic operational impacts. The proposal is supported by the Ward Councillor and staff of Transportation Services.
