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The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the Home Advisory Committee membership at Cummer Lodge.

#### COMMENTS

The Administrator of Cummer Lodge has advised that there are membership changes to the Cummer Lodge Home Advisory Committee.

The Chair of the Home Advisory Committee and the Administrator, together with their members have recruited three (3) new members. The new members will join the committee in January as part of a transition.

In addition, a fourth new member will join the Cummer Lodge Home Advisory Committee at the February meeting.

Cummer Lodge has had a partnership with REENA for several years. James Sejjengo is a resource manager for REENA and the lead for the Long Term Care Partnership with Cummer Lodge and Baycrest Centre for Geriatric Care. He is the co-chair for the Transition Task Group of the Ontario Partnership on Aging and Developmental Disabilities (OPADD). This Task Group was responsible for the publication of the Transition Guide which serves as a roadmap for individuals with a developmental disability transitioning into long-term care homes.

Cummer Lodge's Home Advisory Committee believes that James will be an asset to their Committee and would welcome his perspective.
