**Subject: Item EY30.4, Activities at Certain Business Establishments
in the Etobicoke York District**

The Etobicoke York Community Council at its meeting on October 13, 2009 referred the following motion to the Licensing and Standards Committee:

The Licensing and Standards Committee recommends that:

1. City Council request the Province of Ontario to direct the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) to make it mandatory that a liquor licence hearing be held for any liquor licence violation.
2. City Council request the AGCO, effective immediately, to notify the City of Toronto of any liquor licence hearing pertaining to any establishments located within the City of Toronto.
3. City Council lobby the Province of Ontario to issue liquor licences to the business owner and the owner of the property, as opposed to the current practice of issuing licences to the business owner alone.
