PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION:

To demolish the west portion of the building and to construct a three-storey addition along the west side wall of the existing library building.

REQUESTED VARIANCE(S) TO THE ZONING BY-LAW:

1. Section 320-45B.

The minimum required side yard setback is 7.61 m. The altered building will be located 0.83 m from the Brentwood Road North side lot line.

2. Section 320-40A.(1)

The minimum required front yard setback is 7.54 m. The altered building will be located 5.12 m from the front lot line.

3. Section 320-42A.

The minimum required rear yard setback is 9.05 m. The altered building will be located 1.15 m from the rear lot line.

4. Section 320-59C.

The maximum permitted coverage is 33% of the lot area (321.65 m^2). The altered building will cover 71% of the lot area (692 m^2).

5. Section 320-60.

The maximum permitted height is 11 m. The altered building will have a height of 15.22 m.

6. Section 320-18D.(4)

A minimum of 12 parking spaces are required for the site. No parking spaces will be provided on the site.

7. Section 320-46A.

The maximum permitted gross floor area is 125 m² plus 25% of the lot area (368.68 m²). The existing building has a gross floor area equal to 125 m² plus 129.84% of the lot area (1390.5 m²). The altered building will have a gross floor area equal to 125 m² plus 161.29% of the lot area (1697.1 m²).

THE COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT & MINOR VARIANCES

The role of the Committee of Adjustment is to provide flexibility in dealing with minor adjustments to zoning bylaw requirements. To approve such variances, the Committee must be satisfied that:

- the variance requested is minor;
- the proposal is appropriate for the development of the land and/or building;
- the general intent and purpose of the City's Zoning Code and/or By-law are maintained; and
- the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan are maintained.

The Committee of Adjustment forms its opinion through its detailed review of all material filed with an application, letters received, deputations made at the public hearing and results of site inspections.

The notice has been mailed to you, as required by the *Planning Act*, to ensure that, as an interested person, you may make your views known by:

- Attending the Public Hearing. Attendant Care Services can be made available with some advance notice.
- Sending a letter by Mail or Fax. Information you choose to disclose in your correspondence will be used to receive your views on the relevant issue(s) to enable the Committee to make its decision on this matter. This information will become part of the public record.

If you do not attend the public hearing, or express your views in writing, the Committee may make a decision in your absence, and may recommend changes to the proposal
