City Council, at its meeting on the above date:

1. Referred North York Community Council Item NY22.34 back to the North York Community Council for further consideration.
2. Requested the Director of Community Planning, North York District, to report to North York Community Council at the earliest possible date regarding a by-law to repeal the North York Zoning By-laws and, further, to report on by-laws to re-establish the prohibitions on Reverse Slope Driveways contained in the repealed by-laws (the "Replacement By-laws").
3. Directed the Director of Community Planning, North York District, and the City Clerk to schedule a public meeting, pursuant to the Planning Act, before the North York Community Council for consideration of the repealing by-law and the Replacement By-laws.
4. Requested the North York Community Council to consider the report and recommend to City Council the date on which the Replacement By-laws should be enacted.
