In 2003, Toronto Water purchased the site at 780 Dundas Street East as part of a land assembly for the WWFMP anticipating it would be incorporated as part of the plan in 25 years. It will be the site of a retention tank to hold waters from flowing into the Don River.

The site is vacant and secured and empty. It is a perfect location for a significant community garden.

As it will remain vacant for the foreseeable future, I am requesting that Toronto Water support the development and use of this site as a community garden and that this project be considered in the 2010 Capital Budget.
