SUMMARY

This report requests Council's authority for the City to assume the services with respect to the above development.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

- 1. the services installed for Registered Plan 66M-2359 be assumed and that the City formally assume the roads within the Plan of Subdivision;
- 2. the Legal Services Division be authorized to release the portion of the performance guarantee held with respect to this development Plan 66M-2359;
- 3. an assumption By-law be prepared to assume the public highways and municipal services in Subdivision Plan 66M-2359;
- 4. the City Solicitor be authorized and directed to register the assumption By-law in the Land Registry Office, at the expense of the Owner;
- 5. the City Clerk and Treasurer be authorized to sign any release or other documentation necessary to give effect thereto; and

6. the appropriate City officials be authorized to transfer ownership of the street lighting system constructed with Plan of Subdivision No. 66M-2359 to Toronto Hydro.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Graywood Investments Ltd. entered into a Subdivision Agreement dated August 28, 2000, with the City of Toronto. The performance guarantee for this development 66M-2359 and the development to the south 66M-2363 were submitted jointly. The services for Plan 66M-2363 were assumed by City Council on January 27 and 28, 2009, and the proportionate share of the performance guarantee was released.

COMMENTS

All obligations of the Subdivision Agreement have been completed, all relevant City Divisions have signed the Development Acceptance Form and it is now appropriate for the City to assume the services and for Legal Services to authorize the release of the performance guarantee in respect of this Subdivision Agreement concerning Plan 66M-2359.
