Installation of Special Street Name Sign – “Dave Devall Way”

After 48 years of keeping Torontonians informed and entertained about the weather, CTV broadcaster Dave Devall is set to retire on April 3, 2009.

Mr. Devall was born, raised, and educated in Toronto. While studying Radio and Television Arts at Ryerson, he also served in the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) where part of his training centered on meteorology. In 1956, while still a student, he worked at CFPL-TV and then moved to CFRB where he stayed from 1957-1958. After graduating in 1958, he worked at CHEX-TV in Peterborough. In 1961, CTV was formed and Dave was hired as one of its original six broadcasters

In light of Mr. Devall’s accomplishments and contributions to the City of Toronto, I am recommending that Scarborough Community Council, at its meeting on March 26, 2009, temporarily designate Channel Nine Court as “Dave Devall Way” by installing special signage at this location in advance of Mr. Devall’s retirement on April 3, 2009
