Proposed Traffic Regulation Amendments for the Renaming of Sufferance Road to Village Green Square

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report responds to the renaming of Sufferance Road to Village Green Square from Kennedy Road to the east limit of Village Green Square. This requires amending the existing parking regulation to conform to the new street name.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services, Scarborough District, recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Rescind the parking regulations, as identified in Appendix 1 of this report.
2. Enact the parking regulations, as identified in Appendix 2 of this report.
3. Pass or amend the appropriate by-law(s) accordingly.

Financial Impact

There is no financial impact at this time.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Further to being advised by Survey and Mapping staff, Transportation Services staff has reviewed the traffic regulations for Sufferance Road as they apply to the renaming of this roadway to Village Green Square.

COMMENTS

Several characteristics describing the subject portion of Silver Springs Boulevard include:

- The land use on Village Green Square is commercial and hospitality industry. In addition multi-level residential buildings are being constructed near the easterly limit of this roadway.
- Village Green Square is a two-lane east-west collector road with an unposted speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour and a traffic volume of approximately 7,500 vehicles per day.
- Village Green Square has a pavement width of approximately 10.5 metres.
- Our observations revealed ongoing construction activity in addition to many trips being generated by the hospitality industry.
- Currently parking signage indicating “No Parking Anytime” is in place on both sides of Village Green Square.
- The by-law amendment will allow for enforcement of the parking regulations on Village Green Square.

It is recommended that Transportation Services enact a “No Parking Anytime”, regulation on both sides of Village Green Square, from Kennedy Road to the east limit of Village Green Square.

This will maintain safe and efficient two-way traffic on this roadway. We anticipate that the Parking Regulations enacted for Village Green Square will allow for proper enforcement of these regulations and enhance safety for pedestrians and motorists.
