

## **Appendix “A”**

### **No Parking Adjustments on Dundas Street West, between Bathurst Street and Dovercourt Road**

1. Rescind the “No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays” regulation on the north side of Dundas Street West, between Lakeview Avenue and a point 42.7 metres west of Ossington Avenue.
2. Rescind the “No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday to Friday except Public Holidays” regulation on the north side of Dundas Street West, between Ossington Avenue and a point 44.2 metres west of Shaw Street.
3. Rescind the “No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday to Friday except Public Holidays” regulation on the north side of Dundas Street West, between a point 33.2 metres west of Shaw Street and Spadina Avenue.
4. Implement a “No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday to Friday except Public Holidays” regulation on the north side of Dundas Street West, between Bathurst Street and Spadina Avenue.
5. Rescind the “No Parking, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except Public Holidays” regulation on the south side of Dundas Street West, between Dovercourt Road and a point 29.4 metres west of Grove Avenue.
6. Rescind the “No Parking, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except Public Holidays” regulation on the south side of Dundas Street West, between Grove Avenue and Claremont Street.
7. Rescind the “No Parking, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays” regulation on the south side of Dundas Street West, between Manning Avenue and Bathurst Street.
8. Rescind the “No Parking, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays except Public Holidays” regulation on the south side of Dundas Street West, between a point 48 metres east of Palmerston Avenue and a point 8.5 metres east thereof.
9. Implement a “No Parking, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays except Public Holidays” regulation on the south side of Dundas Street West, between a point 48 metres east of Palmerston Avenue and a point 8.5 metres east thereof.
