BY-LAW No. -2009

To permanently close an untravelled portion of Musgrave Street at Dengate Road

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of Musgrave Street be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Item TE 17.63, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on July 15, 16 and 17, 2008; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council] at its meeting held on _____;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway Musgrave Street, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:
