In your letter of August 1, 2008, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for a Boulevard Café licence at 1627 Dupont Street.

Ballots were mailed out on September 8, 2008 with the last date for filing a response being October 7, 2008. The following is the poll result:

Chapter 190 of the Municipal Code states that a poll can only proceed when at least 25% of the ballots mailed have been returned. This poll did not meet the minimum response rate and therefore is considered negative. Please note that this poll cannot be conducted again until October 7, 2010, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
