# Daycare Pick-up/Drop-off Area and Short Term Parking – Cowan Avenue

### **SUMMARY**

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to designate a "Daycare Pick-up/Drop-off Area", with short-term parking allowed, on the west side of Cowan Avenue in the vicinity of the St Mark's Child Care Centre (201 Cowan Avenue).

The pick-up/drop-off area will provide short-term parking opportunities for parents/guardians to accompany children to St. Mark's Child Care Centre.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Restrict parking to a maximum period of 15 minutes from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the west side of Cowan Avenue, from a point 95 metres south of Queen Street West to a point 20 metres south thereof.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

Transportation Services staff has investigated a request from the St Mark's Child Care Centre (201 Cowan Avenue), to identify a "Daycare Pick-up/Drop-off Area", with short-term parking to assist parents/guardians picking up and dropping off children attending the daycare centre.

#### **COMMENTS**

St. Mark's Child Care Centre (201 Cowan Avenue) is located on the east side of Cowan Avenue, south of Queen Street West. Cowan Avenue is a local roadway operating one-way southbound on a pavement width of 6.1 metres. The posted speed limit is 40 km/h. Stopping is currently prohibited on the east and west sides of Cowan Avenue, from Queen Street West to a point 95 metres further south. Parking is otherwise, prohibited at all times on the east side, with permit parking operating from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily on the west side of Cowan Avenue. Parking is allowed for a maximum period of three hours at all other times. No TTC service provided on Cowan Avenue.

Identifying a "Daycare Pick-up/Drop-off Area" on the west side of Cowan Avenue, between a point 95 metres south of Queen Street West and a point 20 metres further south and allowing parking for a maximum period of 15 minutes from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, is feasible and recommended. A total of three spaces will be provided and the fifteen-minute duration will encourage vehicle turnover.
