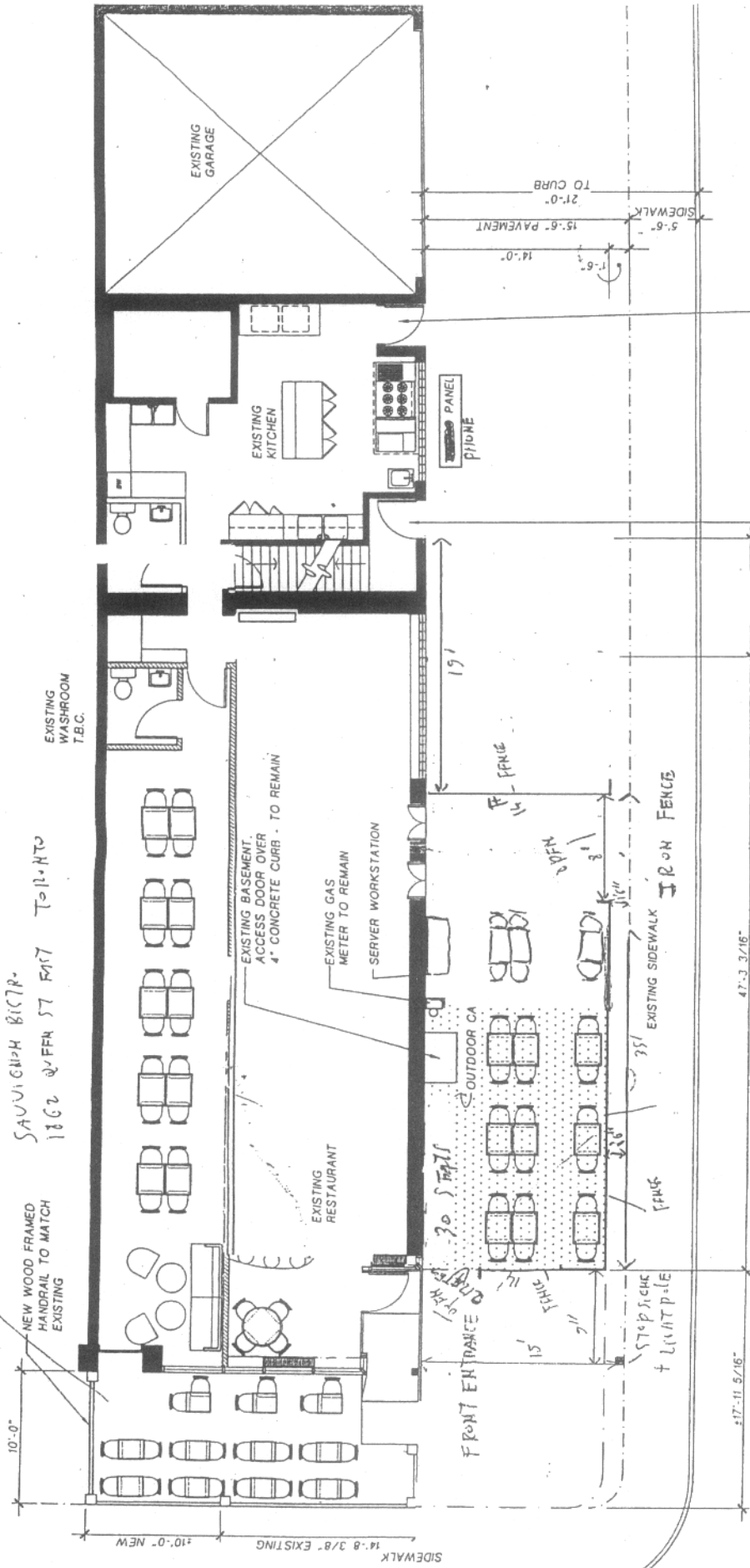

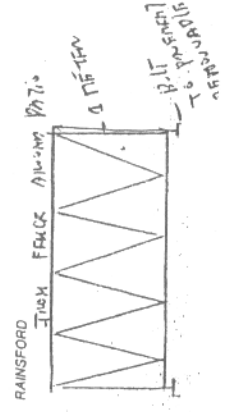

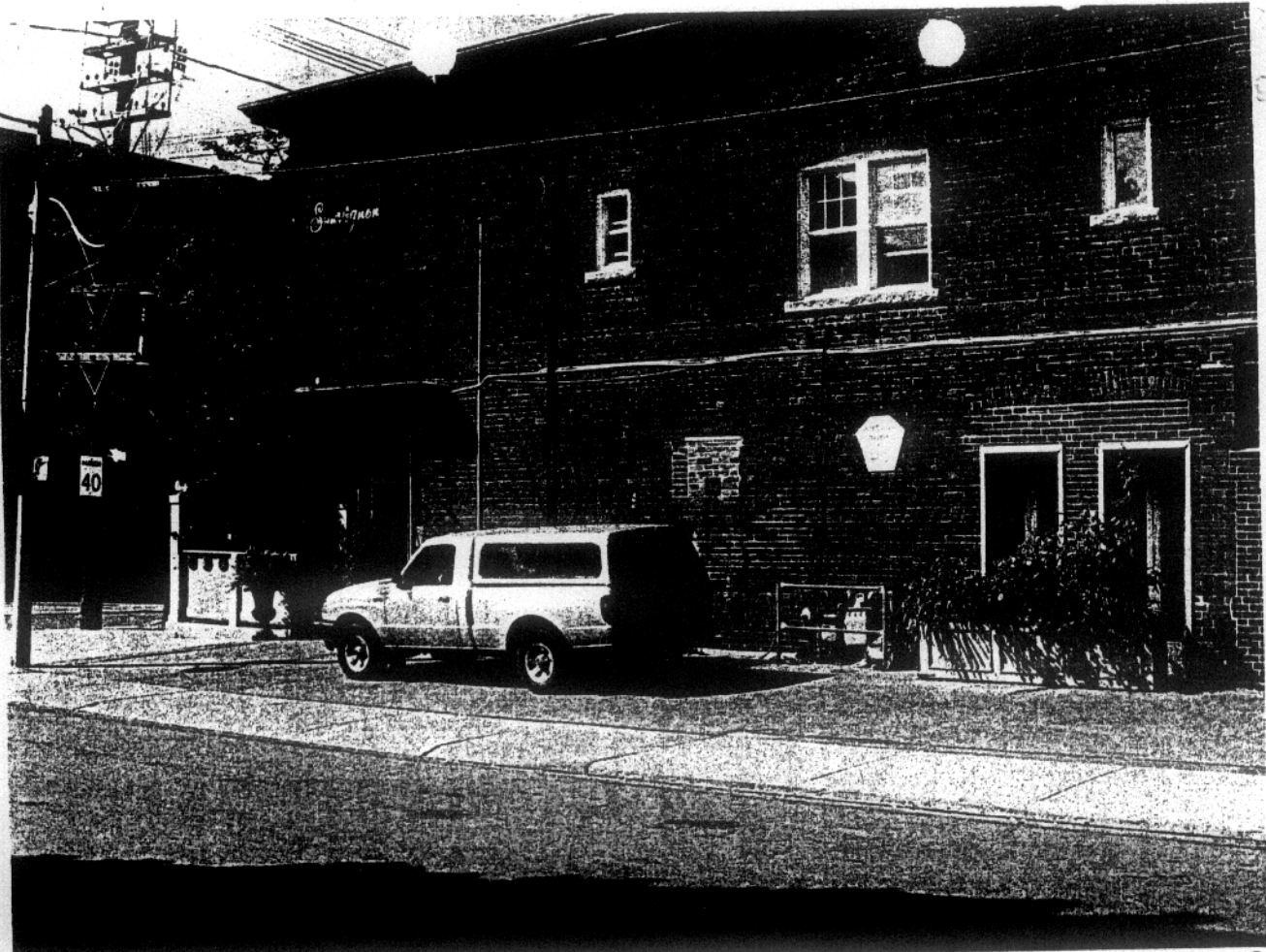
ENTRANCE TO RESIDENCE ON 2ND LEVEL
