BY-LAW No. -2009

To permanently close a portion of the public lane at rear of 3 Kimberley Avenue

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public lane at the rear of 3 Kimberley Avenue be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Item TE19.57, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on October 29 and 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the public lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on May 14, 2009;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane at rear of 3 Kimberley Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:

Part of Lane, Plan 1186, East Toronto, abutting Lots 19 to 25, Block 13,
Plan 635, East Toronto
designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-24265
