BY-LAW No. -2009

To permanently close to vehicular traffic portions of the north boulevard of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East between Leslie Street and Coxwell Avenue

WHEREAS it is recommended that portions of the north boulevard of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East be permanently closed to vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portions of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council] at its meeting held on _____;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Portions of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard East, described as follows, are hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:

Part of the 150 Foot Wide Road on Plan 159E and part of the Water Lot in front of Lot 76 on Plan 214 designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-24029

SECONDLY:

Part of PIN 21393-0115 (LT)

Part of the 150 Foot Wide Road on Plan 159E and part of Block K on Plan

520E designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-24030.
