SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

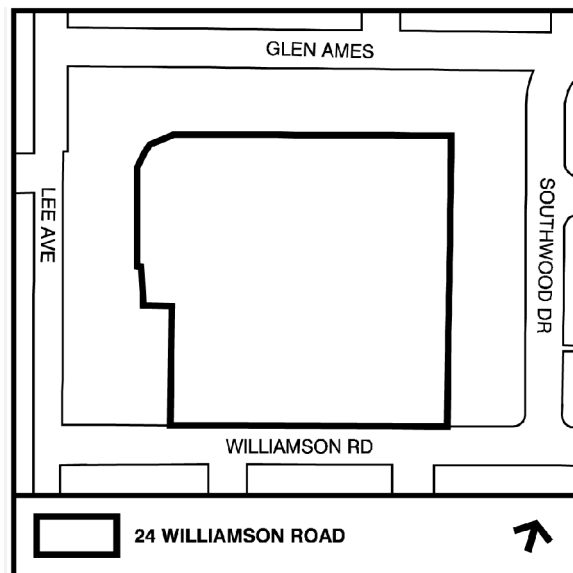
This report reviews and makes recommendations on a request by Lawrence Lamanna with Toronto District School Board, for approval of variances from Chapter 297, Signs, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code to permit, for identification purposes, a non-illuminated ground sign along Williamson Road frontage of the property at 24 Williamson Road.

Staff recommends approval of the application. The variance is minor and within the general intent and purpose of the Municipal Code.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Toronto Building Division recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council approve the requested variances to permit, for identification purposes, a non-illuminated ground sign along Williamson Road frontage of the property at 50 Williamson Road;



and

2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Clerk's Office to advise the applicant, upon approval of a variance, of the requirement to obtain the necessary sign permits from the Chief Building Official.

Financial Impact

The recommendations in this report have no financial impact.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The property is located north of Queen Street East, on the northeast corner of Lee Avenue and Williamson Road in a Residential zone district. The property contains Williamson Junior and Glen Ames Senior Public School building. The applicant is requesting permission to erect, for identification purposes, a non-illuminated ground sign along Williamson Road frontage of the property at 24 Williamson Road. The sign is 2.44m wide and 1.32m high with an area of 3.22m². The height from grade to the top of the sign is 2.46m. The vertical clearance from grade to the bottom of the sign is 1.14m.

The sign does not comply with Chapter 297, Signs, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code in the following ways:

Sign By-law Section and Requirements	Applicant's Proposal	Required Variance
1. Chapter 297-9D (6) (a)	The sign would have an area of 3.22m ² .	The 3.22m ² sign area would exceed by 0.72m ² , the maximum 2.50m ² sign area permitted.

COMMENTS

The variance is required because signs in residential zone districts are required to be small and low in order to limit any adverse impact the signs may have on the property, surrounded residential uses or the streetscape. Although, in this case, the proposed sign is slightly larger than permitted, it is staff's opinion that the proposed non-illuminated sign is well designed and it would not adversely impact the school property, surrounding uses and streetscape.

Staff recommends approval of the application. The variance is minor and within the general intent and purpose of the Municipal Code.

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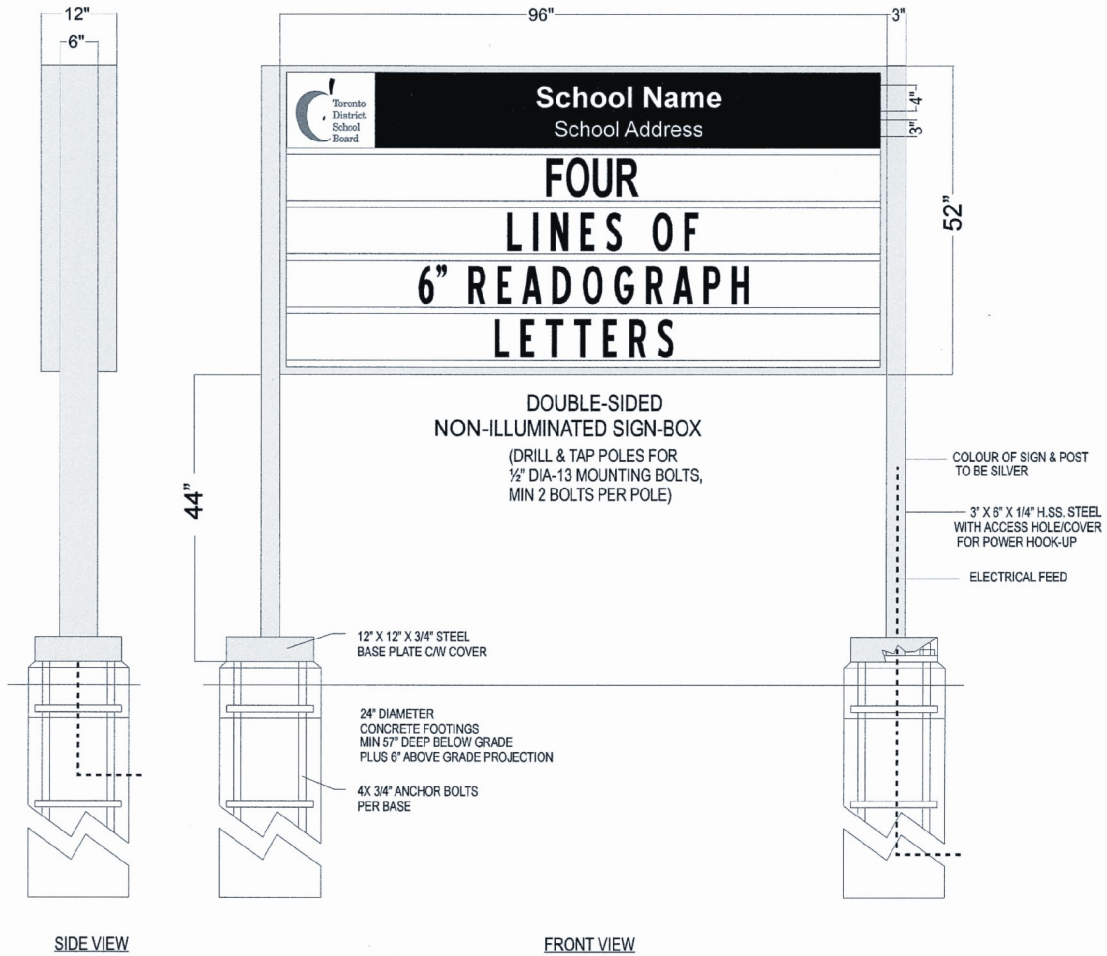
