All precautions for public health and security will be taken and maintained throughout the exhibition.

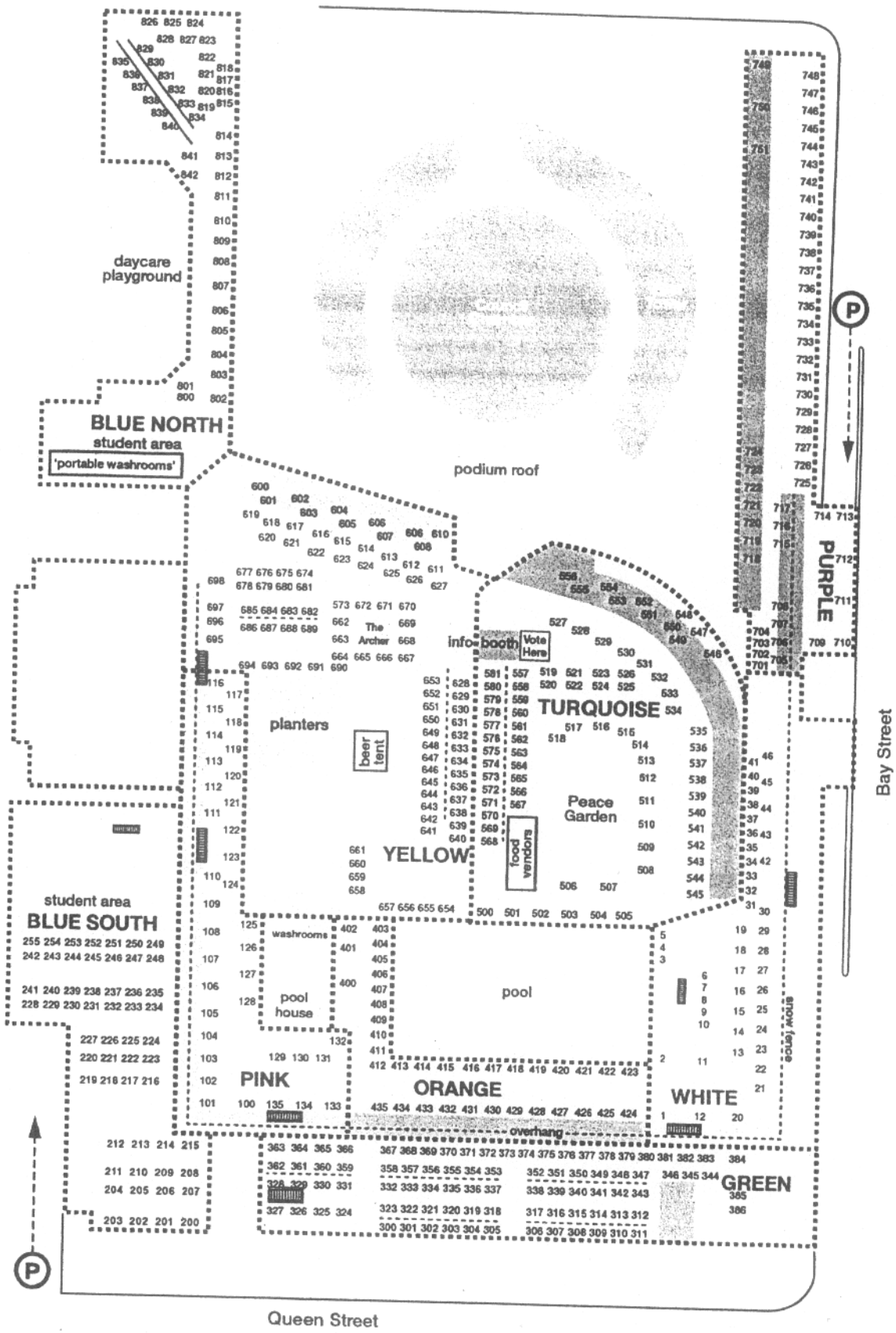
The location of the proposed beer tent is marked on the enclosed map of Nathan Phillips Square.
