Subject: TE27.88 - Events of Municipal Significance - Patio Extensions -Non-Objection to Events for Liquor Licensing Purposes

## Recommendation:

The City Clerk recommends that the various requests seeking endorsement of events of municipal significance for liquor licensing purposes and patio extensions listed on the June 23, 2009, agenda of the Toronto and East York Community Council be received for information, given that these events were processed under the summer recess authority.

## Background:

The following requests seeking endorsement of events of municipal significance for liquor licensing purposes and patio extensions were listed on the June 23, 2009, agenda of the Toronto and East York Community Council, together with a number of requests that would have been listed on the New Business agenda. As this meeting was cancelled due to the recent labour disruption, the respective Ward Councillors were requested to indicate their support prior to a letter being sent to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario on June 22, 2009, indicating that there were no objections to these events taking place.

Patio and Liquor Licence Extensions:

- 1. permission to extend the liquor licences of the following establishments until 4:00 a.m. during the Toronto International Film Festival to be held from September 10 to September 19, 2009:
  - Rosewater Supper Club, 19 Toronto Street, Toronto;
  - Courthouse, 57 Adelaide Street East, Toronto; and
  - The Drake Hotel, 1150 Queen Street West, Toronto;
- patio extensions for the establishments listed in the letter (May 27, 2009) from the Coordinator, Roncesvalles Village BIA during the Polish Festival to be held on September 19 and 20, 2009;



- 3. patio extensions for the establishments listed in the letter (May 22, 2009) from David Wootton during the Sixth Annual Church Street Festish Fair to be held on Sunday, August 16, 2009, between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m.;
