New SSO Facility Update

Background

- Council approved development of two new SSO processing facilities in June 2007. (see City Council June 19, 20 and 21 2007, Report PW6.1 of the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee).
- Two new facilities:
 - Disco SSO Facility: 55,000 tonnes per year at the Disco Transfer Station Site (120 Disco Road).
 - Dufferin SSO Facility: a reconstruction of the existing SSO processing facility at the Dufferin Solid Waste Management Facility (35 Vanley Crescent) to increase its capacity to 55,000 tonnes per year.
- Development approach to be design / build / operate (D/B/O) contracts with an operating term of up to 5 years.

New SSO Facility Update

Disco SSO Facility Status

- RFP for Disco SSO Facility issued 31 March 2009. Closed 21 August.
- Two Proponents, three proposals:
 - Integrated Municipal Services Inc.: Base Proposal
 - AECOM Canada Ltd.: Base Proposal + Alternative Proposal
- Evaluation is ongoing.
- Expect to report in November.
