SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to request approval to implement a "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the north side of Sabrina Drive, from Celestine Drive to a point 30 metres west of Celestine Drive.

This proposed parking prohibition will address the issue of people parking on-street in the area near the intersection of Celestine Drive and Sabrina Drive.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Enacting a "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the north side of Sabrina Drive between Celestine Drive and a point 30 metres west of Celestine Drive.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Transportation Services received a request from Councillor Gloria Lindsay Luby, on behalf of an area resident, to prohibit parking on the north side of Sabrina Drive, between Celestine Drive up to and including 50 Sabrina Drive. A map of the area is Attachment 1.

COMMENTS

Sabrina Drive is an 8.5 metre wide two-way local road built to urban standards with a speed limit of 50 km/h. The street has sidewalks on both sides of the road. The surrounding land area consists of residential dwellings. Parking is currently prohibited on both sides of Celestine Drive between Dixon Road and Sabrina Drive. The intersection of Celestine Drive and Sabrina Drive contains a stop control for east/west traffic.

Transportation Services staff has received a number of complaints, through the Ward Councillor's office, on behalf of an area resident. The concern is with on-street parking occurring on Sabrina Drive, specifically on the north side of the road, just west of Celestine Drive. This has resulted in numerous requests for enforcement of the three-hour limit. As there is a fire hydrant at this corner, motorists park approximately 15 metres west of the intersection in the area in front of 50 Sabrina Drive.

By prohibiting parking on the north side of Sabrina Drive, just west of Celestine Drive, we will ensure that parking does not legally occur on both sides of the road near the intersection. On-street parking will be retained on the remainder of the road, up to the city-wide three-hour time limit.
