## **Green Lanes – U-Turn Prohibition**

## **SUMMARY**

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to propose installing a U-turn prohibition for southbound traffic on Green Lanes, between Bloor Street West and Fieldway Road.

This proposed U-turn prohibition will help to reduce vehicle conflicts on Green Lanes, between Bloor Street West and a point south of Fieldway Road.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. A "No U-Turn Anytime" prohibition for southbound traffic on Green Lanes between Bloor Street West and a point 10 metres south of Fieldway Road.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

Transportation Services received a request from the office of Councillor Peter Milczyn, on behalf of an area resident, to have a southbound U-turn prohibition installed on Green Lanes, between Bloor Street West and Fieldway Road.

A map of the area is Attachment 1.

### COMMENTS

Green Lanes is a two-way local road located in the residential community south of Bloor Street West, west of Islington Avenue. The road, in the area of Fieldway Road, has an urban cross-section: i.e., curb and gutter. The pavement width is approximately 10.3 metres. The legal speed limit on Green Lanes is 40 km/h. Parking is prohibited anytime on both sides of Green Lanes between Bloor Street West and Fieldway Road.

Traffic control signals are installed at the intersection of Bloor Street West/Green Lanes. Staff conducted field observations on Green Lanes, south of Bloor Street West, during the afternoon peak period (4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.). Thirteen southbound vehicles made a U-turn. All of the U- turns occurred within the Green Lanes/ Fieldway Road intersection, south of Bloor Street West.

To address the resident's safety concerns, staff recommends a 24-hour U-turn prohibition on Green Lanes, between Bloor Street West and a point 10 metres south of Fieldway Road, for southbound traffic. This proposed prohibition will help deter U-turn manoeuvres, enhancing traffic safety on this portion of road.
