### 2010 Canadian Open – Parking Regulation Amendments Updates

#### SUMMARY

---

The purpose of this report is to supplement the report to Community Council dated January 20, 2010 titled “2010 Canadian Open – Temporary Road Closings and Parking Regulation Amendments”. This report is prepared further to two public meetings held on March 2, 2010 and March 3, 2010 with Councillor Gloria Lindsay Luby and area residents. As a result of these meetings, and discussions with staff from the Toronto Police Service, additional streets are proposed for parking regulations during the Tournament week (July 19, 2010 to July 25, 2010).

In addition, The Kingsway, between Kipling Avenue and Islington Avenue was originally recommended to also contain the same parking regulations that apply between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., but this street is now recommended to be a No Stopping area during these times. Also recommended is that the regulation be extended further to the east to now encompass the area between Kipling Avenue and Hartsfield Road.

The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) has been rerouted on The Kingsway, therefore City Council approval of this report is required. TTC staff is aware of these recommendations.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

---

**Transportation Services recommends that Council approve:**

1. Introducing temporary parking and stopping regulations on the streets in the vicinity of St. George’s Golf and Country Club as described in Appendix A of this report.

## **Financial Impact**

Approving this report has no financial impact on the City. The Royal Canadian Golf Association organizers are responsible for all costs associated with the proposed temporary parking restrictions.

## **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

In July 2010, the Royal Canadian Golf Association (RCGA) will be hosting the 2010 Canadian Open at St. George's Golf and Country Club in the City of Toronto. As part of this event, Islington Avenue will be closed between Eglinton Avenue West and The Kingsway, for a period up to three weeks, from Saturday, July 10, 2010, to Friday, July 30, 2010.

Prior to this report, five public information meetings have been held including two recent meetings held on March 2, 2010 and March 3, 2010.

## **COMMENTS**

St George's Golf and Country Club is located between Ridgevalley Crescent/Prince George Drive and Princess Margaret Boulevard/Poplar Heights Drive intersections.

Normally, parking is allowed for up to three hours on most of the residential streets in the vicinity of St. George's Golf and Country Club. Leaving this regulation in place will allow event patrons to park on the streets for long durations, potentially reducing the effective road width to one lane of travel; consequently to discourage on-street parking temporary restrictions on adjacent neighbourhood roads will be enacted during the tournament times, (Monday, July 19, 2010 to Sunday, July 25, 2010), between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. As a result of the most recent meetings, the prohibited parking area will be expanded to include additional streets shown in Appendix A.

The Kingsway, between Islington Avenue and Kipling Avenue was originally recommended to also contain the same parking regulation that applies between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. As The Kingsway is the detour route for buses and the location where Islington Avenue is closed at the southerly end, the Toronto Police Service has requested that this road be designated as a No Stopping zone during these hours. We are also recommending that this stopping regulation be extended further beyond the original area to now encompass the area between Kipling Avenue and Hartsfield Road.
